Jacques Lefevre d' Etaples (1455-1536) - A Catholic, Reforming from Within

- Biblical scholar in Patristic History and a Professor at the Sorbonne
 - Pupils: **Guillaume Farel**, **Nicholas Cop**
 - A protected protégé of **Francis I and Marguerite of Navarre**
- **1507**: Moved to a Benedictine abbey, began editing Biblical translations
- **1512**: Produced a Latin commentary on the Epistles of Paul prefaced by 'heresy' (Sola Scriptura, Sola Fide)
- **1522**: Produced the 'Manifesto' of the Reformation
- **1523**: Published the French New Testament - Francis taken captive, freed in 1525
- **1526**: As Royal Librarian at Blois, he published the Pentateuch + *Le Psautier de David*
- **1530**: Published the complete Bible based on Jerome's Vulgate



- **1531: Marguerite of Navarre** protected him from persecution
- **1536-1537:** Lived in Nerac (Navarre) until his death
